

Glen Cove Police Department Response to Reports of Violent Felonies

Purpose:

In accordance with recently enacted New York State legislation, S. 2862 (Chapter 22 Laws of 1999), governing Independent Colleges and Universities, the Webb Institute Board of Trustees has approved a policy to coordinate and provide any necessary assistance in the investigation of any reports of violent felony offenses (as defined in subdivision one Section 70.02 of the Penal Law of the State of New York) occurring at or on the grounds of Webb Institute with the Glen Cove Police Department.

Department Procedures:

<u>Violent Offenses:</u> Upon a report from Webb Institute of any Felony Offense as defined in Section 70.02 of the New York State Penal Law, a Police Officer will respond to the location of the incident and be guided by Nassau County Police Department Manual Operation Order 8110 and 8115 which deal with Preliminary Investigations of Crime and Crime Scene Duties, which will include: Response, Interviews, Notifications, Canvass, Identification of person(s) and solvability, arrest, detention, and the identification and maintenance of a crime scene as applicable.
